For those interested in receiving a COVID-19 vaccination and are in the 1A and 1B category:

As reported in the news Monday, February 1st, the following is a way to schedule your vaccination. Next week on **Tuesday, February 9th, beginning at 12:01 am** until all appointments are taken:

1. Go to the website: <https://www.bellcountyhealth.org/>
2. Look for the words: [Click here for information on the COVID-19 Vaccine](#), and click on the words/link and that will take you to the next screen.
3. Currently the screen you will be taken to looks like this:

COVID-19 VACCINE INFORMATION The vaccine we received is the Pfizer vaccine and you can find the FDA fact sheet below. For questions about the vaccine clinics a phone bank has been established by the County.

Appointments for First Dose for Temple and Killeen are booked. New times will be made available one week at a time.

4. As soon as the scheduling is available, a link to the scheduling page should replace the words: "**Appointments for First Dose . . .**" and you should be able to click on those words if they are underlined to take you to the scheduling page.
5. Be sure to have an email address to use when signing up. Click on a location, if available (Temple or Killeen) and on the calendar, choose a date that is a little darker than the rest, and see what appointments times are available.
6. Click on a date, time and fill out the form with your name and email address. Be sure to click on the " I certify" box and then submit. A confirming email will be sent later.

These instructions are approximate of what will be available on Tuesday, based on previous scheduling process. The new screens should be similar, but could be a little different so just be sure to select a location, date, time, personal info, and "I certify" box before submitting. If you don't have access to the internet or need assistance, contact Danny Clark.

If you are unable to get an appointment next Tuesday, you can sign up on the waitlist or try to sign up again each week when more doses are scheduled to arrive.
